Under the Paraguayan Immigration Law No. 978/96, the following documents are required for submit to the authorities, when applying for “temporary” or “permanent” residence:

- Application form (available at the Immigration Office in Paraguay)
- A valid passport.
- **A certificate of no criminal conviction, issued by the national police authority or judiciary authority of the country of origin and/or of current residence, covering the period of at least the past five years. Applicants under 14 years of age are exempted of this document.**
- A birth certificate and, if applicable, marriage and/or other certificates which attest to the applicant’s civil status.
- A professional license or work certificate accrediting the applicant’s activity or occupation.
- A Medical Certificate issued by proper medical authorities, detailing the applicant’s current psychophysical condition.
- Documents to proof the legal entry into and staying in the country.
- Other documents required by law (see Immigration Office Website).

Documents issued in foreign countries must be apostilled by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. And, documents issued in foreign language must be translated in Spanish by public translators of the Supreme Court of Justice in Paraguay.
